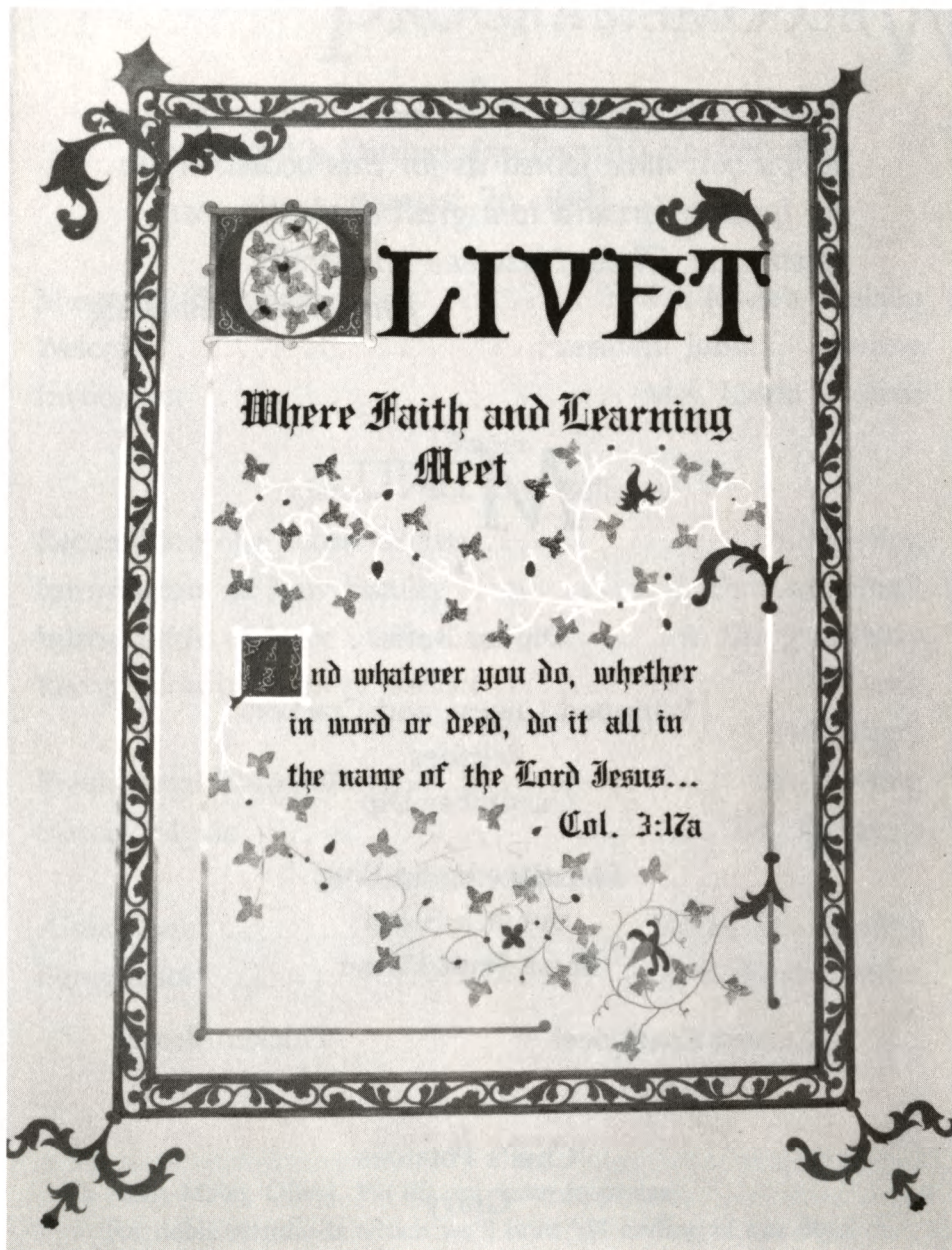

## HARLOW EUGENE HOPKINS

Dr. Harlow Eugene Hopkins joined the teaching staff of Olivet Nazarene University in 1954 and with thirty-seven years of service is the senior member of the faculty. He currently serves as the Chairman of the Division of Fine Arts, a position he has held since 1967.

Harlow was born and reared in Flint, Michigan and is the son of Verda Swank Hopkins and the late Russel Hopkins. His parents joined the Church of the Nazarene in 1942 and attended Nazarene churches in Flint where his father worked for General Motors for forty years.

Dr. Hopkins received a Bachelor of Science in Music Education from Olivet Nazarene College in 1953, a Master's in Music Education from the American Conservatory of Music in 1956, and a Doctor of Music from Indiana University in 1974.

He served a year in Europe while in the Seventh Army Symphony, 1956-57 and spent a portion of his 1984 sabbatical in England and Europe. He has been director of the ONU Concert Band since 1957 and has taken the band to three Nazarene General Assemblies. Harlow is the principal clarinetist for the Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra.

Dr. Hopkins holds membership in a number of professional organizations. He has served as National Secretary for the Christian Instrumental Directors Association since its beginning in 1982. Dr. Hopkins gave strong leadership in the music department's attaining membership in the National Association of Schools of Music in 1982 and was an integral part of the planning group for Larsen Fine Arts Center. In 1986 Harlow founded CODA (Corps of Dedication Associates) for the purpose of raising money for special music department needs. Since its inception CODA has raised nearly \$65,000.

Harlow and his wife, Harriet, have one son, Mark, and two grandchildren, Jason, four, and Dana, two months. He is a member of College Church of the Nazarene and has served as interim minister of music on four occasions. He served on the Church Board for a number of years and has chaired the Building & Property Committee.

For your commitment to leadership in musical excellence throughout a significant tenure here at Olivet Nazarene University as well as for your gentle spirit which consistently emulates Christ, we salute you Harlow Hopkins as the 1991 Faculty Member of the Year.

MARY DILLMAN GATES

There is a sense in which Mary Gates represents the significant cohort of custodial staff throughout the campus of Olivet Nazarene University. Her loyalty to the standards of Olivet have been a source of appreciation for many of us who have observed her across these years.

Having been born into a parsonage in St. Francisville, Illinois, on a Sunday morning, Mary says the book PAPA WAS A PREACHER pretty much fits her. When her father, a Free Methodist minister, found out he had a daughter, after five sons, he took the day off from church responsibilities to stay at home with Mary and her mother. "Being raised in a parsonage was great, especially with six brothers. They always treated me with love and respect."

Mary graduated from Arcola High School in 1945 and attended business college in Mattoon, Illinois, where her father pastored the Church of the Nazarene. She then took a job with the Illinois Central Railroad as a ticket reservation clerk and transferred to Kankakee in 1956. "I loved the railroad work and to this day when I hear the whistle of a train I am reminded that it's still in my blood after all these years."

Even in her teen years Mary was active in her father's church where she taught junior high Sunday school and

played the piano. "The church has been a wonderful support for me and my family throughout my life."

Mary has two daughters, Robyn Elizabeth and Karyn Sue; and three grandsons. One of her brothers, Beryl, served as a faculty member at Olivet during the 1960s and just recently retired as professor of education at Point Loma Nazarene College.

When talking about her upcoming retirement from Olivet in December, Mary says, "I will miss my work in Burke. I recently told someone that I wish I were ten years younger so I could stay with Burke since it has become my second home. Early in my work at Olivet I was cleaning in a professor's office and the Lord said to me, why don't you pray for this prof and his family? From then on I have considered my routine work a ministry, and as I enter the various office I pray God's blessings on that professor and his family. Olivet has been good to me, and I'm especially proud to have put my youngest daughter through college at Olivet.
