SIGNIFICANCE OF THE COLORS OF THE ACADEMIC REGALIA

The degree colors of academic hoods are appropriate to the category of the degree, rather than to the scholar's major subject. These colors are used for the edging of all hoods, along with the colors of the school. The colors may also be used for the velvet facing and sleeve bars of doctors' gowns, and tassels on bachelors' and masters' caps.

The appropriate color for degrees in Arts and Letters (B.A., M.A.) is *white*; in Commerce, *drab*; in Education, *light blue*; in Engineering, *orange*; in Fine Arts, *pink*; in Humanities, *crimson*; in Law, *purple*; in Library Science, *lemon*; in Medicine, *green*; in Music, *pink*; in Pharmacy, *olive*; in Philosophy (Ph.D.), *dark blue*; in Physical Education, *sage green*; in Science, *golden yellow*; in Theology, *scarlet*.
