# President's Special Recognitions

## D. George Dunbar

In 1956 George Dunbar emigrated from northwestern Canada to enroll in Olivet. After receiving two degrees here in music, he began teaching at Cascade College. He returned to Olivet in 1969 to teach voice, church music and choral directing. He earned the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in 1970 from the University of Southern California.

His leadership of the prestigious Orpheus Choir has been enhanced by his emphasis upon music with texts from Scripture, by his complete choral musicianship and consistent Christian character. He has led the Orpheus Choir as they were featured at two PraiseGatherings in Indianapolis with 9,000 in attendance, and at the National Music Educators' Convention, Dr. Dunbar led all the Nazarene college musicians in three services at the General Assembly in June, 1980. His recent initiation of the Church Music Institute on our campus gives additional acclaim to Olivet.

## Richard Matheny

Since 1964 Richard Matheny has been Foreman of Grounds and Moving on Olivet's campus. The unending task of campus grooming is performed with persistence and patience to achieve the beauty we all love on this campus. His mechanical skills keep the college vehicles and motors running well. These important tasks for Olivet's well-being are accomplished with grace and personal pride in his work.

Behind these mechanical skills is a man of loyalty to his home, church and college; a team man who has balanced family responsibilities with occupational involvement. Richard Matheny is worthy of emulation for his quality of personhood in the Olivet community.
