The colors, sizes and shapes of academic gowns, hoods, and tassels are the symbols by which the degree and the school awarding the degree may be recognized. The size and shape emphasize the degree level — the Doctor hood and gown being the largest, followed by the Master and the Bachelor.

The colors in the satin lining of the hood are those approved and authorized by the college or university. . . and the color or the velvet border indicates the degree earned (*dark blue* for Philosophy, *light blue* for Education, *golden yellow* for Science, *scarlet* for Theology, etc.).

Academic colors used in hoods and tassels include: Agriculture — *Maize*, Architecture — *Blue Violet*, Arts, Letters, Humanities — *White*, Commerce, Accountancy, Business — *Drab*, Dentistry — *Lilac*, Economics — *Copper*, Education — *Light Blue*, Engineering — *Orange*, Fine Arts — *Brown*, Forestry — *Russet*, Home Economics — *Maroon*, Journalism, Communications — *Crimson*, Law — *Purple*, Library Science — *Lemon*, Medicine, Hospital Administration — *Kelly Green*, Music — *Pink*, Nursing — *Apricot*, Oratory (Speech) — *Silver Gray*, Pharmacy — *Olive Green*, Philosophy — *Dark Blue*, Physical Education — *Sage Green*, Public Administration — *Peacock Blue*, Public Health — *Salmon Pink*, Science — *Golden Yellow*, Social Work — *Citron*, Theology — *Scarlet*, Veterinary Science — *Gray*. *From a publication of the Collegiate Cap and Gown Company.*
