Could frame thy fearful symmetry?

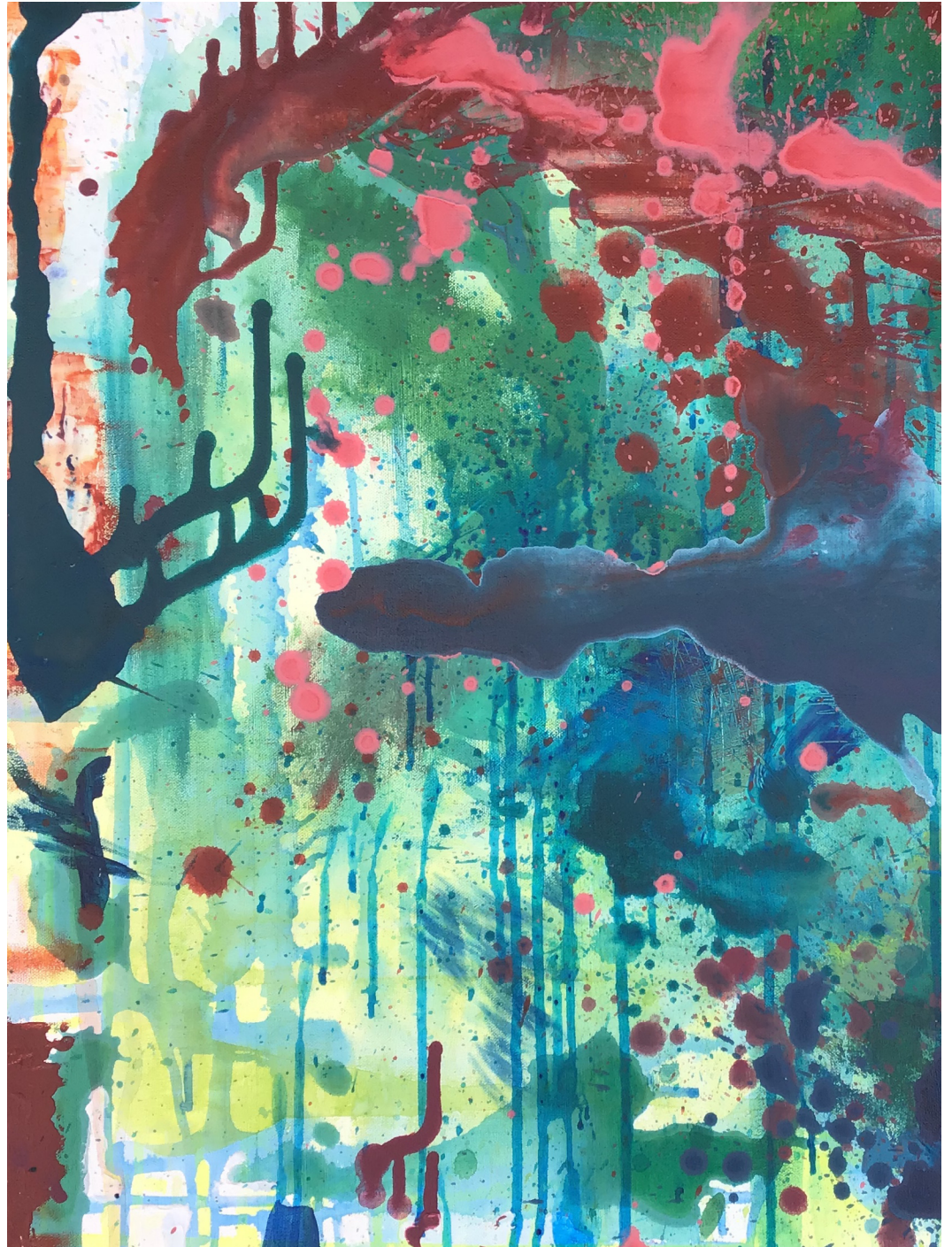
In what distant deeps or skies,
