## ANDREW MELLON OBSERVES HIS 75TH BIRTHDAY

Washington, March 24—(AP)—With a quiet and unobtrusiveness in keeping with his character, Andrew W. Mellon, who his friends call the greatest secretary of the treasury since Hamilton, today observed the seventy-fifth anniversary of his birth.

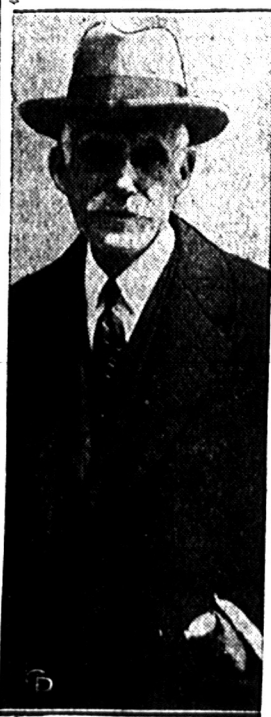
The cares of building the financial destinies of the world's richest nation were left behind in Washington, and the little, slender little man whose vigor seems unimpaired by the years returned to Pittsburgh the city that for a lifetime has been his home, for the celebration.

He looked back upon a life crowded with activity, first in the field of finance and then in that of government which has brought him world wide renown and made him for nine years the center of one of America's never-ceasing political controversies.

Entering public life at an age when most men count their days of activity as past, Mr. Mellon became a member of President Harding's cabinet in the trying post war days, served under President Coolidge and now under President Hoover, giving him the distinction of being the only man in history to hold the treasury portfolio under three chief executives.

In Washington, he has lived quietly. He walks back and forth each day between the treasury and his apartment near Dupont Circle, enters but slightly into the social life of the capital and spends eight or ten hours a day at work. He shuns publicity and gives but few speeches. Aside from his governmental and financial activities, Mr. Mellon has achieved much fame as an art collector. He owns many rare old paintings of fabulous value and his home in Pittsburgh is a veritable gallery of masterpieces.

## MAHATMA GANDHI BELIEVED HE IS WINNING FIGHT

Broach, Bombay, Mar. 24—(AP)—Belief that the government is weakening has been created among some of Mahatma Gandhi's followers in his campaign to attain Indian independence.

This belief they base upon the light sentence which was given J. M. Sengupta, mayor of Calcutta, who was sent to jail for ten days on a charge of seditious utterance, and upon statement by Sir George Schuster in the legislative assembly that the government had decided to refer the entire question of the salt tax to the tariff board.

Gandhi is said to have indicated this belief in a speech at Buva, when in expressing regret that the elders of the village boycotted him, he asked if they were afraid of the government that was afraid to arrest him although he was openly breaking the law and making fiery speeches.

The Mahatma also announced he wished that women who can arrange satisfactorily for case of their children should join in the civil disobedience campaign against the British government. He explained that he neither desired nor expected women to neglect their children in furthering the cause.

Two sets of women volunteers are contemplated, one to take an active part in the civil disobedience campaign and the other for propaganda work. It was understood that Gandhi's wife will lead the first party of 37 volunteers from Asraf, proceeding by train to Bulsar and Titel where they will violate the salt laws.

## CHARGING ELEPHANT DON'T WORRY PRINCE

Rhino Camp, Uganda, British East Africa, Mar. 24—(AP)—Crashing, lumbering with giant strides toward the Prince of Wales, a great bull elephant was killed by hunters a few days ago when it charged the British heir. The pachyderm stumbled and fell, never to rise again, within 20 yards of his royal highness.

The hunters accompanying him shouted warnings as the elephant, angered at invasion of his retreat, lifted his trunk, and trumpeting, started directly for the party. No shots were fired until it was seen the prince was so intent on his picture he did not realize his danger. The prince broke camp here Saturday and started on his safari into the Belgian Congo. He appears the picture of health, and is browned and sunburned.

## RESUSCITATION DEMONSTRATION AT FIRE HOUSE

A very interesting demonstration in resuscitation was given Saturday afternoon at the city hall fire station by William Marc Burbridge, representative of the Mine Safety Appliance Company. Quite a large crowd was present, including firemen from the two stations, both the working and off shifts, several registered nurses from the state hospital, industrial heads, and other interested parties.

Mr. Burbridge demonstrated the proper method of artificial respiration in cases of drowning, electrical shock, or exposure to gas, and explained what physical changes occurred in the body in such cases. He spoke particularly of the deadly carbon monoxide gas, as is accumulated in garages when an automobile motor is running, from some gas stoves, or from heating stoves not properly controlled. He also demonstrated the new gas mask safety helmet, first aid kit which have been developed for the use of firemen.

The principal part of Mr. Burbridge's talk, however, was devoted to the "H. H. Inhalator", a device which has been developed to replace the old lungmotor and pulmotor machines. The most interesting feature of this machine is that it furnishes to the patient a mixture of 95 percent pure oxygen and 5 percent carbon dioxide, the latter gas being added to stimulate the motor cells in the body and cause respiration to start naturally. This mixture of gases is not administered under pressure, but inhalation and exhalation is caused by artificial respiration going on while the oxygen and carbon dioxide is being administered.

## JUST ANOTHER IS TAKEN FOR A RIDE

Chicago, Mar. 24—(AP)—Another "ride" victim was tossed onto the roadside yesterday where the bodies of John (Dingbat) Obera and his bodyguard, Sam (Th Shadow) Malaga, were found several weeks ago.

Throughout the day, the body was unidentified, though police believed the slaying was an aftermath in the hostilities that brought death to the "Dingbat" and his bodyguard.

Last night, one policeman identified the victim as "Bones"—whom he had often seen in stockyard districts saloons and who was a reputed Salts gangster.

## PINCHED BECAUSE HE DROVE TOO SLOW

Chicago, March 24—(AP)—Police in suburban Niles have grown so used to seeing automobiles whiz by that they are now suspicious when one goes slowly.

Yesterday Henry Wheat was driving through at about 10 miles an hour. Police Chief P. Peter Osokowski, on the assumption that no one driving that slowly could be out for any good reason, halted him.

All persons desiring may file objections in said Court before said day upon the question of whether or not the matters and facts contained in said certificate are true, and may appear at the hearing and make their defense.
